- Lots of government changes in the horizon at the City and Provincial Level
- Have made much gains in the last 10 years but now there is a change
- · Now with new government, the mantra is that childcare should be a parental choice
- No consultation is taking place within the province
- Funding cuts is going to be expected in the next 18 months
- For profit threshold is changing, need to watch this very carefully as the city should not be advocating for big box childcare in Toronto
- Need to be careful in regards to for profit funding
- Expansion has halted and cut from \$48 million to \$25 million
- Tax rebate are up to \$6,000/year, costing government \$389 million dollars, where will that money come from?

  - Harder to cut money from what is allocated, easier to cut money that hasn't been confirmed
  - Childcare Service Plan by Childrens Services is being worked on for the next five years, consultation should be starting in January
  - New children's services director: Shanley and Karen Gray sharing the job at 5 months each
  - ° Lots of wins this year with stabilization funding and the increase in the GOG
  - Significant fundraising with Bingo
  - ° Two new programs:
    - Community Builder, \$350 to join and centres can apply for a community grant of \$500 for toys and curriculum
    - How does Learning Happen workshop with Sue Hunter, series of 3 workshop for \$125.00/person
